

This Indenture, Made this 21st day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six between Aloyse Renner of Lawrence and eighty six between Aloyse Renner of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and John Bandwelen of the second part. Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars, to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, he sold and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The East half of the South East quarter except the North Seventeen (17) acres thereof in Section number Seventeen (17) also beginning at the South East corner of said Section number Seventeen (17) thence South Eight (8) chs. and Fifty (50) links thence West three (3) chs and Fifty Three (53) links thence North Eight (8) chs and Fifty (50) links thence East Three (3) chs and Fifty Three (53) links being Three (3) acres also beginning South Three (3) chs and Fifty (50) links West of said South East corner thence South Two (2) chs and Fifty (50) links thence East Four (4) chs thence North Two (2) chs and Fifty (50) links thence West Four (4) chs being One (1) acre All in Town number Fourteen (14) Range number Twenty (20) East of the Sixth P.M. and containing Sixty Eleven (61) acres more or less

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part therein. And the said Aloyse Renner does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and he does further expressly waive all benefits of Homestead provided by Section 9, Article 15 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas or any statute in pursuance thereof. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note
