

This Indenture, Made this 27th day of November, 1886
by and between Robert T. Caldwell (single) of the County
of Jackson and State of Missouri of the first part
and Annie Lane Johnson of the County of Jackson
and State of Missouri of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part,
in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred
and ^{no} Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowl-
edged, and of the debt hereinafter mentioned, does
by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey
unto the said party of the second part, her heirs
and assigns, all the following described Real Estate,
situated in the County of Douglas and State of
Kansas to wit:

Lot numbered Fifty one (51) on Vermont
Street in the City of Lawrence in the said
County of Douglas and State of Kansas; Being
the same lot upon which the Lawrence Hotel
is situated

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all
and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, heredi-
taments and appurtenances thereto belonging,
or in anywise appertaining, forever, upon this
express condition to wit: That, whereas, the said
Robert T. Caldwell has this day executed and
delivered his certain promissory note to said
party of the second part, in words and
and figures as follows, which note is given
as a part of the purchase money for the
