This Indenture, Made this 18th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven between Aug. C. Siler and Bessie B. Siler in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and John McClay of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of the North East quarter of Section One (1) Township Fourteen (14) of Range twenty (20)

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful
