Public 11. Deeds

This Indenture, Made this 9th day of April a.D. 1887 between P. G. Keohane a single man of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the first part, and Mrs W. U. Quayle of Osage County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and 00 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas to wit:

Lots Ninety one (91) and Ninety Two (92) Chapel Street Baldwin City Kansas

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said P. G. Keohane has this day executed and delivered a certain promissory bond & 2 coupons in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a description. Bond for \$300 payable one year after date at Baldwin City Bank Two coupons for \$15⁰⁰ ea payable on the day of Oct and Apr respectively

Now, if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above describe bond & coupons mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same
