The South East quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section Four (4) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty (20) except the S.E. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of said quarter and two (2) acres off the East half of South East quarter of said quarter being 8 rods east and west by 40 rods north and south and the West half (W 1/2) of the South West quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section three (3) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty (20)
