confessed and acknowledged, he granted, bargained,
sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the
second part and to her heirs and assigns forever, all
the following described piece and parcel of land lying
and situate in the City of Lawrence County of Douglas
and State of Kansas, to wit:

Lot North half of Seven in Block No. Twelve (12) Lane
Place Addition.

And said first parties agree to keep the building on said
premises insured to the amount of Two Hundred Dollars
for the benefit of the said party of the second part and assigns
to have and to hold the same, with all and singular the
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto
the party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns
forever. And the said Parties of the first part do hereby
covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof they are
the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and
devised of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that
they will Warrant and defend the same in the quiet
and peaceable possession of said party of the second
part, her heirs and assigns forever, against all persons
lawfully claiming the same.

money of the United States of America, being for a
loan thereof on the day and date hereof, made by the
said Mary J. Smith to the said Parties of the first
part and secured to be paid by the certain promissory
note of the said parties of the first part bearing even
