This Indenture, Made this twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, between William F. Young and Hannah Maria Young (his wife) of Media in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part and William H. Doyle of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit:

The east one fourth (1/4) of the North half (1/2) of the North West quarter (1/4) of Section (14) Township Fifteen (15) Range nineteen (19), Containing in all (20) acres, more or less. with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said William F. Young and Hannah Maria Young, (his wf.) do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.
