

This Indenture, Made this First day of January
A.D. 1887, between Richard Tarpy and Anna
Tarpy, his wife of Douglas County, in the State
of Kansas, of the first part, and the Kansas
Loan and Trust Company of Shawnee County
in the State of Kansas of the second part;

Witnesseth, That said parties
of the first part in consideration of the sum
of One Hundred and Twenty Dollars, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these
present, grant, bargain, sell, and convey
unto the said party of the second part,
its heirs and assigns, all the following
described real estate, situated in the
County of Douglas and State of Kansas
to wit:

The South east quarter of Section
No Thirty seven (37) in Township No Thirteen
(13) South, of Range No Eighteen (18) East of the
Sixth P.M.

Containing One hundred and Sixty
(160) Acres, more or less.

To have and to hold the same with
all and singular the tenements, hered-
itaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging,
or in any wise appertaining, forever;

Provided Always, And these presents
are upon this express condition, that
whereas said Richard Tarpy and Anna
Tarpy have this day executed and delivered
one certain promissory note to said
party of the second part, for the sum of
One Hundred and Twenty Dollars, bearing
even date herewith, payable at the office
of The Kansas Loan and Trust Company,
Topeka, Kansas, in equal installments
of Twelve Dollars each, the first installment
payable on the First day of July, 1887, the
second installment on the First day of
January 1888, and one installment on the
First days of July and January in each
year thereafter, until the entire sum is
