This Indenture, Made this 28th day of January
in the year of our Lord, one thousand
eight hundred and eighty seven, between
William Coate and Eunice Coate, his wife
of Keeper in the County of Douglas and
State of Kansas, of the first part, and
G. H. E. Griffith of the second part:

It is agreed, That the said parties
of the first part, in consideration of
the sum of Five Hundred (500) Dollars,
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
mortgage to the said party of the second
part, his heirs and assigns forever, all
that tract or parcel of land situated in
the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,
