This Indenture, Made this Twentyfourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven, between Christian Long and Elizabeth Long his wife of the county of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Crispen Lawrence & Co., of Concord, New Hampshire, of the second part; Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid by the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the parties of the second part this heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The East half of the South West quarter of Section sixteen (16) and the East half of the South East quarter of Section Eight (8) all in Town Fifteen (15) Range Nineteen (19) East and containing One hundred and sixty (160) acres, more or less, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title, and interest of the parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.
