Executors of the estate of Geo. Ford Deceased of the second
part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in
consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty
Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and mortgage to the said parties of the
second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all that
tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas
and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The East half of the South West quarter of Section
Number Twenty(20) of Township Fourteen(14) in Range
Nineteen(19) with the appurtenances, and all the estate,
title and interest of the said parties of the first part
therein. And the said Peter Q. Beck does hereby covenant
and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful
owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good
and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and
clear of all incumbrances and he does further expressly
waive all benefits of Homestead provided by Section 9,
Article 15 of the constitution of the State of Kansas or any
statute in pursuance thereof. This Grant is intended
as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of three
hundred & twenty Dollars, according to the terms of one
certain note this day executed and delivered by the
said Peter Q. Beck and Mary Q. Beck to the said G.
Groenewor & Rachel H. Ford Executors estate of Geo. Ford
deceased payable at the office of G. Groenewor & Son as follows,
to wit:

Three hundred & twenty dollars on the 17th day of February 1890.

thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance
is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall
