

This Indenture, Made this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven
between Henry M. Greene and Maggie M. Greene his wife (being
of lawful age) of the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas,
of the first part, and Edward Russell of Lawrence Kans. of
the second part,

Witnesseth, that the parties of the first
part, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars
to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant,
bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second
part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tracts or
parcels of land situated in the County of Douglas and
State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point North $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 573 feet from the
North east corner of the South west quarter of the South-
east quarter of section Thirty four(34) in Township Eleven(11)
of Range Eighteen(18), thence North 243 feet, thence East
383 feet, thence North 766 feet, thence North 58° West 833
feet, thence South 1450 feet, thence East 383 feet to the
beginning containing $19\frac{5}{8}$ acres, and being formerly
known as Lots 1 to 19 inclusive in Block Two(2), Lots 1 to 30
inclusive in Block Three(3), Lots 1 to 34 inclusive in
Block Four(4) and all of Block Five(5) except 4 lots in what
is known as the town of Leavenworth - being the
cornerstone of said parties of the first part: but the parties
of the first part reserve the right to pay \$100⁰⁰ or any
multiple thereof at the end of any year, by paying 30 days
extra interest thereon, with the appurtenances, and all
the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the
first part therein. And the said parties of the first part
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof
they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted,
and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of
inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances;
that they have good right to sell and convey said
premises, and that they will Warrant and Defend the
same against the lawful claims of all persons.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the
payment of the sum of Five hundred Dollars and interest
thereon, according to the terms of one certain mortgage note
and ten interest notes or coupons, this day executed by the
