by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey to
the parties of the second part their heirs and assigns
forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the
County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as
follows, to wit:

hundred and twenty two (122) and One hundred and
twenty four (124) on Monroe Street in Baldwin City
according to the recorded plat thereof.

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest
of the party of the first part therein. And the said
party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree
that at the delivery she is the lawful owner of the
premises above granted, and seized of a good and
indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear
of all incumbrances, and that she will Warrant and
Defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This
grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment
of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, according to the
terms of one certain promissory bond made by the said
Valinda B. Dugger to the parties of the second part. Said
promissory bond being given for the sum of Five hundred
Dollars, dated March 18th 1887 due and payable in five
years from the date thereof, with interest thereon payable
semi annually from the date thereof until paid, according
to the terms of said promissory bond and ten certain
coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be
void if such payments be made as in said promissory
bond and coupons thereto attached, and as hereinafter
