acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents does
grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said parties of
the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all
that tract or parcel of land situated in the County
of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:
The North one half of Lots Numbered One hundred
and Fourteen(114) One hundred and Sixteen(116) One
hundred and Eighteen(118) One hundred and Twenty
(120) One hundred and Twenty Two(122) and One
hundred and Twenty four(124) on Monroe Street
according to the recorded plat of Baldwin City
Subject to a prior mortgage to Crupper, Lawrence &
Co. of Five hundred(500) Dollars.
