

This Indenture, Made this Nineteenth day of March  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty seven, between Fremont Gilges and Annie  
B. Gilges Husband and Wife of the County of Douglas  
and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Crippen  
Lawrence & Co. of Concord, New Hampshire, of the  
second part,

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first  
part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand  
Dollars, to them in hand paid by the parties of the  
second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
sell and convey to the parties of the second part, their  
heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of  
land situated in the County of Douglas and State  
of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

The West half of the South West quarter of Section  
Thirty three (33) Town Fourteen (14) Range Nineteen (19)

East and containing Eighty (80) acres more or less.

with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and  
interest of the parties of the first part therein. And the  
said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and  
agree that at the delivery hereof they are the  
lawful owners of the premises above granted, and  
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of  
inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances  
and that they will warrant and defend the same  
against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended  
as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

One Thousand Dollars, according to the terms of one  
certain promissory bond made by the said Fremont  
Gilges and Annie B. Gilges to the parties of the second  
part. Said promissory bond being given for the  
sum of One Thousand Dollars, dated March 19<sup>th</sup>

1887, due and payable in five years from the date  
thereof, with interest thereon payable semi-annually  
from the date thereof until paid, according to the  
terms of said promissory bond and ten certain  
coupons thereto attached. And this conveyance shall be  
void if such payments be made as in said promissory  
bond and coupons thereto attached, and as is  
hereinafter specified. And the parties of the first part

payment of the Bond by the foregoing mortgagee, second, and as aforesaid.
