

And upon forfeiture of this Mortgage, or in case of default in any of the payments herein provided for, the second part, les, their heirs, successors and assigns, shall be entitled to a judgment for the sum due upon said note, and the additional sum paid by virtue of this Mortgage, with interest on said additional sums so paid at the rate of ten per cent, per annum from the date of payment of said sums, and costs, and a decree for the sale of said premises in satisfaction of said judgment, foreclosing all rights and equities in and to said premises of the said first part, les, their heirs, successors, and assigns, and all persons claiming under them.
