## Subordination To Easement

WHEREAS, G. A. McTaggart and Ester M. McTaggart, husband and wife,

executed a certain mortgage ~~to~~ to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, of New York, New York,  
 dated August 23, 1958 to secure the payment of Nine Thousand Dollars,  
 covering lands therein described, recorded in Book 120, Page 139 of the records  
 of Douglas County, State of Kansas

AND, WHEREAS, the above named mortgagor G. A. McTaggart conveyed by easement to  
Kansas City Power and Light Company, hereinafter called the second party,  
 certain rights permitting the construction, operation and maintenance of  
an electrical transmission line across approximately 1600 feet

of this farm, and the second party desires the consent of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company to said easement  
 described as follows:

An easement dated March 30, 1965, from G. A. McTaggart and Ester M. McTaggart, husband and wife, to the Kansas City Power and Light Company to construct an electrical transmission line across approximately 1,600 feet of that portion of the land described in the aforesaid Mortgage located in the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-seven, in Township Fourteen South, of Range Twenty-one East, together with the right of ingress and egress to and from the same.
