**Kansas Real Estate Mortgage**

**This Indenture.** Made this 1st day of October, A.D. 1965, between

**WITNESSETH: THAT SAID PART I** OF THE FIRST PART, in consideration of the sum  
of ONE THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey  
unto said part I of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real  
estate situated in Douglas County and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot Eleven (11), in Block Twenty-Two (22), in Sinclair's Addition, an Addition  
to the City of Lawrence.

**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME,** Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, forever.

**PROVIDED ALWAYS,** And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said  
parties of the first part

have this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to said

parties of the second part, of which the following is provided: FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the undersigned promise to pay to the order of Charles W. Hedges and L. Yvonne Hedges, the sum of One Thousand and 00/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars with interest at the rate of Five, (5) % per annum on the unpaid balance until paid. The principal and interest shall be payable to the office of the payee at 802 Massachusetts, Lawrence, Kansas or at such other place as the holder hereof may designate in writing to the payee. The said note shall be paid in full on or before January 1, 1967.

Presentment, protest and notice are hereby waived. The undersigned also waive the benefit of any homestead or exemption right as against the debt evidenced hereby.

Privilege is reserved to pay the debt in whole, or in an amount equal to \$100.00 or more at any time.

Now, if said parties of the first part shall pay, or cause to be paid, to said part I of the second part, their heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall and by these presents become due and payable, and said part I of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
