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thereunder, may make such repairs and take such steps as it deems advisable to prevent or cure such waste, and for any of said purposes Mortgagee may advance such sums of money as it deem necessary. Mortgagee shall be the sole judge of the legality, validity and priority of any such claim, lien, encumbrance, tax, assessment and premium, and of the amount necessary to be paid in satisfaction thereof.

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8. If default be made in payment of any installment of principal or interest of said note or any part thereof when due, or in payment, when due, of any other sum secured hereby, or in performance of any of Mortgapor's obligations, covenants or agreements hereunder.

(a) All of the indebtedness secured hereby shall become and be immediately due and payable at the option of Wortearce, without notice or demand which are hereby expressly waived, and this mortgage may be foreclosed at any time after such default. Any judgment for the foreclosure of this mortgage shall provide that all the land herein described shall be sold together and not in separate parcels.

(b) Irrespective of whether fortgapes accelerates the maturity of all indebtedness secured hereby, or institutes foreclosure proceedings, Mortgagee may collect the rents, issues and profits of the premises, and may enter and take possession chargof and manage and operate the same and take any action which, in Mortgagee's judgment, is necessary or proper to conserve the value of the premises, or Mortgagee at it's option may have a receiver appointed by the Court to take possession of the premises, to ... manage, onerste and conserve the value thereof and to collect the rents, issues and profits thereof. Fither Mortrages or such receiver may also take possession of, and for these purposes use, any and dl personal property contained in the premises and used the by Mortragor in the rental or ileasing thereof or any part thereof. The right to enter and take possession of the premises and use any' personal property therein, to manage, operate and conserve the same, and to collect the rents, issues and profits thereof, whether by a receiver or otherwise, shall be in addition to all other rights or
