

become liable for such other advances, including (but not exclusively) interest at the rate set forth in the mortgage and note, taxes, assessments, sewer and water rents, ground rents and hazard insurance premiums, in accordance with the terms of said instruments or as said terms may, from time to time, be modified or changed, and these liabilities shall continue in the future even though either or both of the parties of the second part have bona fide parted with said mortgaged property and with every interest therein.

2. The parties of the second part, jointly and severally, hereby assume liability to, and become liable to, the United States Government for the contract of William J. Arnold, one of the parties of the first part, to indemnify the United States Government for any amounts paid or loss suffered by the Administrator of Veterans Affairs on account of the liabilities of said William J. Arnold under the provisions of the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944, as amended, and the Veterans Administration Regulations issued pursuant thereto, or Chapter 37, Title 38, U.S. Code.

3. The word "note" as used in this instrument shall be construed to include note, bond, extension or modification agreement, or other instrument, evidencing the loan indebtedness or other advances under or secured by said mortgage, all as hereinabove mentioned or referred to; and the word "mortgage" shall be construed to include mortgage, deed of trust, mortgage deed, or other instrument securing said loan indebtedness and (or) securing any (other) said advances made pursuant to such "mortgage". The singular number shall include the plural, and the plural shall include the singular. To any extent applicable, these definitions also shall apply to the provisions executed below by the Administrator of Veterans Affairs.

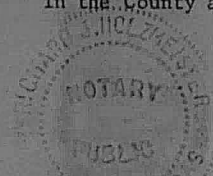
