Is conserve the value of the premises, or Mortgages at its option may have a receiver appointed by the Court to take possession of the premises, to manage, operate and conserve the value thereof and to collect the rents, issues and profits thereof. Either Mortgages or such receiver may also take possession of, and for these purposes use, any and all personal property contained in the premises and used by Mortgagor in the rental or leasing thereof or any part thereof. Mortgagee may, at any time and from time, either before or after the maturity of said note, and without notice or consent:

a. Release any person liable for payment of all or any part of the indebtedness or for the performance of any obligation.
b. Make any agreement extending the time or otherwise altering the terms of payment of all or any part of the indebtedness, or modifying or waiving any obligation, or subordinating, modifying or otherwise dealing with the lien or charge hereof.
c. Exercise or refrain from exercising or waive any right Mortgagee may have.
d. Accept additional security of any kind.
e. Release or otherwise deal with any property, real or personal, securing the indebtedness, including all or any part of the property mortgaged hereby.

16. Any agreement hereafter made by Mortgagor and Mortgagee pursuant to this mortgage shall be superior to the rights of the holder of any intervening lien or encumbrance.

17. If Mortgagor herein is a corporation, it wholly waives the period of redemption from forcelosure and agrees that when sale is had under any decree of forcelosure against it, the Sheriff making such sale, or his successor in office, is authorized to execute at once a deed to the purchaser.
18. When all indebtedness secured hereby has been paid, this mortgage and all assignments herein contained shall be void and this mortgage shall be released by Mortgagee at the cost and expense of Mortgagor; otherwise to remain in full force and affect.

19. This mortgage shall inure to and bind the heirs, legatees, deviseos, administrators, executors, trustees, successors and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used herein, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the Unse of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
