

Douglas of Sharphy County, in the State of Kansas, of the first part, and CAPITOL FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSO-CLATION of Topeks, Kansas, of the second part; WITNESSETH: That said first parties, in consideration of the loss of the sum of Nineteen Thousand and No/100----------DOLLARS made to them by second party, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents mortgage and warrant unto said second party, its successors and assigns, all of the following-described real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: Lot Thirteen (13) and the West Half of Lot Fourteen (1h) in Strong's Addition, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas (It is understood and agreed that this is a purchase money mortgage.) Together with all heating, lighting, and plumbing equipment and fixtures, including stokers and burners, screens, awnings, storm windows and doors, and window shades or blinds, used on or in connection with said property, whether the same are now located on said property or hereafter placed thereon. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, With all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances there-unto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever, and hereby warrant the title to the same. DOLLARS with interest thereon, advanced by said Capitol Federal Savings and Loan Association, and such charges as may become due to said second party under the terms and conditions of the note secured hereby, which note is by this reference made a part hereof, to be repaid as follows: In monthly installments of \$ 128.29 each, including both principal and interest. It is the intention and agreement of the parties hereto that this mortgage shall also secure any future advancements made to first parties, or any of them, by second party, and any and all indebtedness in addition to the amount above stated which the first parties, or any of them, may owe to the second party, however evidenced, whether by note, book account or otherwise. This mortgage shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto and their hirs, personal repre-sentatives, successors and assigns, until all amounts due hereunder, including future advancements, are paid in full, with in-terest; and upon the maturing of the present indebtedness for any cause, the total debt on any such additional loans shall at the same time and for the same specified causes be considered matured and draw ten per cent interest and be collectible out of the proceeds of sale through foreclosure or otherwise. of the proceeds of sale through foreclosure or otherwise. First parties agree to keep and maintain the buildings now on said premises or which may be hereafter erected thereon ingeod'condition at all times, and not suffer waste or permit a unisance thereon. First parties also agree to pay all taxes, satesaments and insurance premiums as required by second party. First parties also agree to pay all cast, charges and expenses reasonably incurred or paid at any time by second party, including adspract expenses, because of the failure of first parties to perform or comply with the provisions in said agree and in this aborgage contained, and the same are hereby secured by this mortgage. First parties before assign to second party the rents and income arising at any and all times from the property mort-property and collect all rents and income and apply the same on the pament of insurance premiums, taxes, assessments, re-parts or improvements necessary to keep and party the rents and be conducted on the relation, or other charges or payments provided for infinite in finite part, is also agreed to the having of possession hereunder shall in no manner prevent or retard accord party in the collection of said sums by foreclosure or otherwise. The failure of second party to assert any of its right hargender at any time shall not be construed as a waiver of its The failure of second party to assert any of its right hereunder at any time shall not be construed as a waiver of its right to assert the same at a later time, and to insist upon and enforce strict compliance with all the terms and provisions in said note and in this mortgage contained. If said first parties shall cause to be paid to second party the entire amount due it hereunder and under the terms and provisions of said note hereby secured, including future advances, and any extensions or renewals hereof, in accordance with the terms and provisions thereof, and comply with all the provisions in asid note and in this mortgage contained, then these presents shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect, and second party shall be entitled to the immediate pos-session of all of said premises and may, at its option, declare the whole of said note and mayable and have foreclosure of this mortgage or take any other legal action to protect its rights, and from the date of such default all items of indebt-edness hereunder shall draw interest at the rate of 10% per annum. Appraisement and all benefits of homestead and ex-emption laws are hereby waived.
