But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises, or any part thereof, are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, or if insurance premiums are not paid when due, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereof, shall become due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, and said mortgagee shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.

This mortgage shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the respective parties.
