CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

The undersigned further certify that on the 4 day of March, 1971, the by-laws of the Church provided in Article IV, Property Rights, as follows:

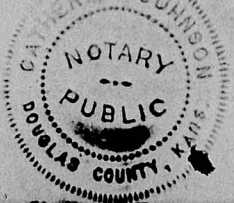
- (a) Property, real, or chattel, shall be taken, held, sold, transferred, or conveyed in the Church or corporate name.
- (b) No real, or chattel property of the Assembly shall be sold, leased, mortgaged, or otherwise alienated without the same shall have been authorized by at least two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the quorum present at the business meeting called for that purpose.

(c) The Pastor and Secretary of the Church shall certify in such conveyance, lease or mortgage, that the same has been duly authorized by the vote of the Church. Such certificate shall be held to be conclusive evidence thereof.

The undersigned further certify that at a special meeting of the Church held on the 4 day of March, 1971, which meeting was called in accordance with the constitution and by-laws and at which a quorum was present, a resolution was passed authorizing the official Board of the Church to mortgage the following described real estate located in the City of Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas:
