

these presents shall be null and void. But if said sum of money or any interest thereon is not paid when the same is due and payable, or if any taxes or assessments levied against said property are not paid when the same are payable, then in either of these cases the whole of said sum mentioned in said note together with the interest thereon, shall and by this indenture does immediately become due and payable at the option of the said party of the second part or his assigns, to be at any time thereafter exercised without notice to the party of the first part. But the legal holder of this mortgage may at option pay or cause to be paid the said taxes and assessments so due and payable, and charge them against said party of the first part. And the amounts so charged shall be an additional lien upon the said mortgaged property, and may be enforced and collected in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured, together with interest at the rate of twelve per cent per annum, payable annually until fully paid and discharged. But whether the party of the second part elect to pay such taxes and assessments or not, it is distinctly understood that in all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated, then in like manner the said note and the whole of the said sum shall immediately become due and payable, and the said mortgagee or his assigns may immediately cause this mortgage to be foreclosed, and shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises and the rents, issues & profits thereof. And the said party of the first part hereby waives all benefits of the stay, valuation or appraisement laws of the State of Kansas.
