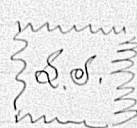

Parsons of the County of Jackson and State of Missouri of the second part Witnesseth, that said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of one dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the debt hereinafter mentioned do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit: All of lots numbered Seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) of block numbered four (4). Also lots numbered twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22) of block numbered three (3) all of Tyler Place, an Addition to Lawrence Kansas. And the said Symon D. Clements and Elizabeth Clements do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery
