Daly & John Daley, her husband, to Thomas V. Harris, and which said mortgages, Malita J. Daly and John Daley, as well as the sons and agents of said Thomas V. Harris, W. A. H. Harris and Vernon H. Harris assured said deponent were the same notes secured by a mortgage recorded in Book 5 of the Mortgage Records of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, at page 357, and which bears date also of August 22 1883, and that said notes were the only unpaid notes secured by said mortgage, and furthermore said sons of Thomas V.
