This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, according to the terms of one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said Albert Hase & Mary Hase to the said Mary M. Lewis payable at the office of G. Grover & Son Lawrence Ks as follows, to wit:

Three hundred dollars on the 28th day of June 1892 with the interest thereon at 8 per cent per annum to the said party of the second part. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not, at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators, ^{and assigns} and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and a reasonable attorney's fee for foreclosure of this mortgage, the said fee to be due and payable on filing petition for foreclosure, and the overplus, if any there shall be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said Albert Hase his heirs or assigns.
