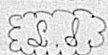

Know all Men by these Presents: That the Lombard Investment Company, of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to it in hand paid by William Postwick of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does sell, assign and convey unto the said party of the second part, all its right, title and interest in and to a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 26th day of Sept. in the year 1885, made by Frederick W.
