

the amount of the said coupons then delinquent, and all the sums so paid for insurance, taxes, assessments, and to release statutory lien claims, with interest upon all said sums at the rate of twelve per centum per annum, and the proceeds of foreclosure and sale under this mortgage shall be applied in the payment of the entire amount so found to be due.

Sale under foreclosure may be made with or without appraisement, at option of party foreclosing.
