

This Indenture, Made this 25th day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven between Henry F.uel and Harriet A. F.uel, his wife, of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and The Home Building and Loan Association of the City of Lawrence, said County of Douglas, of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the parties of the first, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars, to them duly paid have sold, and by these presents do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, and its assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situated in said Douglas County, and State of Kansas, and described as follows, to wit:

Lot No. One hundred and Four (104) on Indiana Street, in Block No. Forty (40), West Lawrence also Lot One hundred and Six (106) on Indiana Street, in Block No. Forty (40), West Lawrence, said last named Lot being covered by a mortgage of Two hundred (\$200.) Dollars, to which this mortgage is subject.

With the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the parties of the first part therein.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage, to secure the payment and the full performance of all the obligations and conditions of a certain Bond this day executed by the said Henry F.uel to the said Home Building and Loan Association, for the payment of \$200. as therein provided; and upon the full and prompt performance of all said conditions of said bond by the party signing the same, this conveyance shall be void. But if default be made in the performance of any of the conditions of said bond, or in the making of any payment therein provided when the same shall be due; or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are assessed or levied against said premises are not paid at the time when the same are by law made due and payable, then upon the happening of any of said failures, the whole of the said sum of \$200, together with such fines and penalties as shall accrue, under the By-Laws of said Association, shall immediately become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, or its assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount of said bond, to wit: \$200, less only the amount of all dues paid as principal upon said bond, together with the cost and charges of making such sale, and
