

be enforced and collected in the same manner as the principal debt hereby secured, together with interest at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum, payable annually, until fully paid and discharged; but whether the party of the second part elect to pay such taxes and assessments or not, it is distinctly understood that in all cases of delinquencies as above enumerated, then, in like manner, the said note and the whole of the said sum shall immediately become due and payable, and the said mortgagee or his assigns may immediately cause this mortgage to be foreclosed, and shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises and the rents, issues and profits thereof. And the said parties of the first part hereby waive all benefits of the stay, valuation or appraisement laws of the State of Kansas.
