Herd of Grant of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, all right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, I may have acquired in, through or by a certain Indenture or Mortgage Deed, bearing date the seventeenth day of February A.D. 1882 and recorded in the Recorder's office of Douglas County, and State of Kansas in Book 3 of Deeds, page 14 to the premises therein described, to-wit:

South half of the South West quarter of Section twenty one (21) Township twelve (12) Range twenty (20) Containing Eighty (80) acres of land more or less.

And which said Mortgage was made to secure the payment of six certain promissory notes amounting to twenty two hundred dollars, bearing even date with said Deed, for the sum of Three Hundred sixty six Dollars and Sixty seven cents, each.
