 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
 dred and eighty seven, between James H. Price and
 Matilda B. Price Husband and Wife and James M.
 Price unmarried of the county of Douglas and State
 of Kansas, of the first part, and Orispen, Lawrence
 Ego, of Concord, New Hampshire of the second part;
 Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in
 consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and
 Fifty Dollars, to them in hand paid by the parties
 of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do
 grant, bargain, sell and convey to the parties of the
 second part their heirs and assigns forever, all
 that tract or parcel of land situated in the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described
 as follows, to-wit: Lots numbered One (1) Two (2)
 and Three (3) on Washington Street and Lots num-
 bered Ten (10) Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) in Block num-
 ber Seventy Seven (27) on Main Street comprising One
 half Block between Third (3rd) and Fourth (4th) Streets
 Palmyra Addition to Baldwin City -
 with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title, and
 interest of the parties of the first part therein. And
 the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant
 and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the
 lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized
 in a good and indefeasible state of inheritance therein,
 free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will
 Warrant and defend the same against all claims
