This Indenture, Made this first day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and eighty seven by and between Samuel S. Campbell and Lucy J. Campbell, his wife of Boston of the County of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts parties of the first part and the Suffolk Trust and Investment Co. of Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, party of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand Dollars, to us in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part and to its successors or assigns forever, all of the following described tracts, pieces or parcels of land lying and situate in County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

The West Half of the North East Quarter
 the North Half of South West Quarter
 the North West Quarter of South East Quarter
 and the North West Quarter of Section Fourteen of Township Fourteen (4) Range Nineteen, Douglas County, Kansas

Containing Three hundred and sixty acres more or less To have and to hold the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of homestead exemption, unto the said party of the second part, and its successors or assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree, that, at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate in inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will Warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part, and its successors or assigns forever against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

Provided always, And this instrument is made, executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to wit:

First: Said parties of the first part are justly indebted unto the said party of the second part in the principal
