Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to-wit: Lots Fifteen, 15, Sixteen, 16, and Seventeen, 17, in Block One Hundred and Eighty 180, in the City of Endora County and State aforesaid

To Have and to Hold the same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever.
