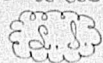

This Indenture, Made this Twenty fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six between James Bennett and Mary Bennett, husband and wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Anna G. M. Menger of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:
Lots numbered One hundred and fifty three (153), ^{and one hundred and fifty five (155)} on Connecticut Street in the City of Lawrence, County and State aforesaid, subject however to a mortgage made on or about June 1st 1886 by said first parties in favor of Mary Barnes to secure the payment of the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said James Bennett and Mary Bennett do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises
