This Indenture, Made this sixth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight, between Pryor Wallace and Martha A. Wallace his wife (being of lawful age) of the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Edward Russell, Lawrence Kansas of the second part: Witnesseth that the parties of the first part, for consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:
