Know all Men by these Presents, That I Jacob Schillinger of the County of Rock Island and State of Illinois for and in consideration of One Dollar, to me in hand paid, and for other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed, do hereby grant, bargain, remise, convey, release and quit-claim unto Robert Bartsch of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever I may have acquired in, through, or by a certain Indenture or Mortgage Deed, bearing date the 24th day of October A.D. 1878, and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Douglas County, State of Kansas in Book A. of Page 154 to the premises therein described, to-wit: One Acre out of a fractional quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section four (4) in Township thirteen (13) Range twenty one (21) described as follows: Commencing on a point on the Kansas River forty (40) rods east from the line of the Eudora Town site and running from thence south twenty (20) rods thence east eight (8) rods, thence north twenty (20) rods, thence west eight (8) rods to the place of beginning And which said Mortgage deed was made to secure one certain promissory note bearing even date with said deed, for the sum of One thousand \$ Dollars and—cents.
