This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Sixty five dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said John Blaney to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the money arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said John Blaney his heirs and assigns.
