This Indenture, made the 11th day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-eight, between The First Presbyterian Church of Baldwin, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas connected with the Synod of Kansas, and Presbytery of Topeka, party of the first part, and The Board of the Church Erection Fund, of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America, party of the second part.

Whereas, the said party of the first part has applied to the said party of the second part for aid to enable it to erect or possess a House of Worship, adapted to its wants; and whereas the said party of the second part has granted such aid to the amount of Six Hundred (\$600) ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars.

Now therefore, this Indenture witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the above amount, doth hereby covenant, grant, promise, and agree to and with said party of the second part, and doth hereby become bound unto it as follows, that in case the said Church or corporation, party of the first part, shall cease to be connected with the said General Assembly, or the corporate existence of the said party of the first part shall cease, or its house of worship on the mortgaged premises
