

duties as shall be specified in such instrument. If the Trustee shall request the Company to do so, the Company shall join with the Trustee in the execution and delivery of such instrument, but the Trustee shall have the power to make such appointment without making such request or without such joinder.

(b) Every such separate trustee and co-trustee shall, to the extent permitted by law, be subject to the following terms and conditions:

(1) The rights, powers, duties and obligations conferred or imposed upon such separate trustee or co-trustee shall be conferred or imposed upon and exercised or performed by the Trustee and such separate trustee or co-trustee jointly, as provided in the instrument appointing him or it.

(2) All powers, duties, obligations and rights conferred upon the Trustees (including such separate trustee or co-trustee), in respect of the custody of all cash deposited hereunder, shall be exercised solely by the Trustee.

(3) The Trustee may, at any time, by written instrument, accept the resignation of or remove any such separate trustee or co-trustee. Upon the request of the Trustee, the Company shall join with the Trustee in the execution and delivery of such instrument, but the Trustee shall have the power to accept such resignation or make such removal without making such request and without such joinder. A successor to a separate trustee or co-trustee so resigning or removed may be appointed in the manner provided in this Section.

(c) Upon the written acceptance by such separate trustee or co-trustee, he or it shall be vested with the estates and property specified in the instrument of appointment, either jointly with the Trustees, or separately, as may be provided therein, subject to all the trusts, conditions and provisions of this Indenture. Each such instrument of appointment shall be filed with the Trustee. Any separate trustee or co-trustee may, at any time, by written instrument, constitute the Trustee, his or its agent or attorney-in-fact with full power and authority, to the extent permitted by law, to do all acts and things
