and to exercise all discretion authorized or permitted to him or it for and in his or its behalf and name. If any separate trustee or co-trustee shall be dissolved, become incapable of acting, resign or be removed, all the estates, property, rights, powers, trusts, duties and obligations of such separate trustee or cotrustee, to the extent permitted by law, shall vest in and be exercised by the Trustees, without the appointment of a successor to such separate trustee or co-trustee.

(d) Any notice, request or other writing, by or on behalf of the holders of the Notes and delivered to the Trustee shall be deemed to have been delivered to the Individual Trustee and all separate trustees and co-trustees.

Section 9.7. <u>Liability of Trustees</u>. No trustee under this Indenture shall be personally liable by reason of any act or omission of any other trustee under this Indenture.

Section 9.8. <u>Segregation of Moneys</u>. All moneys received by the Trustees pursuant to this Indenture shall be held in trust for the purposes for which they were paid. Such moneys need not, except as otherwise provided herein and to the extent required by law, be segregated from any other moneys, and may be deposited by the Trustees under such general conditions as may be prescribed by law in the general banking department of the Trustee, and the Trustee shall not be liable for any interest thereon.

Section 9.9. <u>Illegal Acts</u>. No provision of this Indenture shall be deemed to impose any duty or obligation on the Trustee to perform any act in the execution of the trusts created by this Indenture or to exercise any right, power, duty or obligation conferred or imposed on it, which under any present or future law shall be unlawful, or which shall be beyond the corporate powers, authorization or qualification of the Trustee. Any such act and exercise shall be performed and exercised by the Individual Trustee or by any separate trustee or co-trustee appointed as provided in Section 9.6, provided, that the same shall not be unlawful or beyond his or its powers, authorization or qualifications.
