

And the Mortgagor covenants with the Mortgagee that he is lawfully seized in fee of the premises hereby conveyed, that he as good right to sell and convey the same, as aforesaid, and that he will warrant and defend the title thereto forever against the claims and demands of all persons wi omsoever.

This mortgage is given to secure the payment of the principal sum of Fifteen Thousand Five and No/100 - - - - - = Dollars (\$ 15,550.00) as evidenced by a certain promissory acte of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference payable with interest at the rate of Seven per centum (7 per annum on the unpaid balance until paid, principal and interest to be paid at the office of CAPPTOL PEDERAL SAUTH In Topoka, Kansas or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of One Hundred Mar and 91/100-----Dollars (\$ 109.91)), commencing on the first day of October 1971, and on the first day of each month thereafter, until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of September, 1996

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows

1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note at the times and in the manner therein provided. Privilege is reserved to pay the debt in whole, or in an amount equal to one or note monthly payments on the principal that are next due on the note, on the first day of any month prior to maturity. Provided, however, that written notice of an intention to exercise such privilege is given at least thirty (30) days prior to prepayment, and provided further that in the event the debt is paid in full prior to naturity and at that time it is insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, he will pay to the Mortgagee an adjusted premium charge of one per centum (1.5) of the original principal amount thereof, except that in no event shall the adjusted premium exceed the aggregate amount of premium charges which would have been payable if the mortgage had continued to be insured until maturity, such payment to be applied by the Mortgagee upon its obligation to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development on account of mortgage insurance.

2. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, the Mortgagor will pay to the Mortgagee until the said note is fully paid, the following sums

- (a) An amount sufficient to provide the holder hereof with funds to pay the next mortgage insurance premium if this instrument and the note secured hereby are in ured, or a monthly charge (in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) if they are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, as follows:
 - If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are insured or are reinsured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, an amount sufficient to accumulate in the hands of the holder one (1) month prior to its due date the annual mortgage insurance premium, in order to provide such holder with the funds to pay such premium to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to the National Housing Act, as amiended, and applicable Regulations thereunder, or
 If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are insured or are reinsured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, as amiended, and applicable Regulations thereunder, or
 - (11) If and so long as said note of even date and this instrument are held by the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, a monthly charge (in lieu of a mortgage insurance premium) which shall be in an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12) of one-half (½) per centum of the average outstanding balance due on the note computed without taking into account delinquencies or prepayment;
- (b) A sum equal to the ground rents if any and the taxes and special assessments next due on the premises covered by this mortgage, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance on the premises covered hereby (all as estimated by the Mortgage) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgagee in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and assessments will become the form the same become delinquent and. taxes and special assessments, before the same become delinquent; and
- (c) All payments mentioned in the two preceding subsections of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Mortgagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagee to the following items in the order set forth:
 - premium charges under the contract of insurance with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, or monthly charge (in lieu of mortgage insurance premium), as the case may be;
- (fl) ground rents, if any, taxes, assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums; (III) interest on the note secured hereby; and

(IV) amortization of the principal of said note. Any deficiency in the amount of such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. The Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed two cents (2¢) for each dollar (\$1) of each payment more than fifteen (15) days in arreas to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.

3. That if the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage for ground rents, taxes and assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess at the option of the Mortgage, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgage (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be such excess at the option of the Mortgagee, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor. If, however, the monthly payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents, taxes and assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, then the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgage any amount necessary to make up the deliciency, on or before the date when payment of such ground rents, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time the Mortgagor shall tender to the Mortgagee, in accordance with the provisions of the note secured hiereby, full payment of the entire indebtedness represented thereby, the Mortgagee shall, in computing the amount of such indebtedness, credit to the account of the Mortgagor all payments made under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2 hereof, which the Mortgage has not become obligated to pay to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, and any balance remaining in the funds accumulated under the provisions of (b) of paragraph 2 hereof. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby or if the Mortgage acquires the property otherwise after default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under said note and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (a) of paragraph 2.

4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and in default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same.

5. That he will keep the premises above conveyed in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and tear excepted.
