This Indenture, Made this fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, between Hannibal H. Robe, single (being of lawful age) of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Edward Russell, Lawrence, Kansas, of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The West One half of Block Twenty-six in West Lawrence in the City of Lawrence, County and State aforesaid.

I warrant reserving the right to pay Fifty Dollars or any multiple thereof at the maturity of any coupon, on the principal of the debt hereby secured, with the aforesaid premises and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein, And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises aforesaid, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances; that he has good right to sell and convey said premises, and that he will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claim of all persons.
