grant, bargain, sell and convey, to the said party of the second part  
its representatives or assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land

follows, to wit: Lot Eighty Three (83) on Elm Street lots One hundred  $\frac{25}{100}$   
Twenty (120) & One hundred  $\frac{25}{100}$  Twenty Two (122) on Dearborn Street in

To Have and To Hold the same, together with all the heredit-  
aments and appurtenances, and all the estate, title & interest  
of the said party of the first part therein forever.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of

notes of even date herewith, this day executed and delivered by the
