paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby
composed and acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and con-
veyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns for
ever, all the following described piece and parcel of land lying and
situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lot No. 14 of Block No. 15 (then 16) and Lot No. 15 of Block No.
16 (then 17), in that part of the City of Lawrence known as West
Lawrence, being the homestead of the said parties of the first part,
except, however, to right of way of the Kansas Midland and
Victorians, Atoka and Santa Fe Railroad companies

to have and to hold the same, with all and singular the here-
ditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, unto
the party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, for
ever. And the said William Mansfield & Clara C. Mansfield
do hereby, covenant and agree, that at the delivery hereof they
are the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of
a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free
and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant
and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable posses-
sion of said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns
forever, against all persons lawfully claiming the same.

Provided always, And these presents are upon this ex-
press condition, that whereas, the said William Mansfield
and Clara C. Mansfield are justly indebted unto the said
W. C. Beardsley in the principal sum of Twenty-five Hundred
Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, being
a loan thereof on the day and date hereof, made by the
said W. C. Beardsley to the said William Mansfield & Clara C.
Mansfield and secured to be paid by the certain promissory
note of the said William Mansfield and Clara C. Mansfield bear-
ing date herewith, payable to the order of the said W. C.
Beardsley in five years from the date thereof, at his office, in
Albany, New York, with interest after maturity, or default in
payment of interest, at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum
until the said principal sum is fully paid. The interest on
said note from date to maturity, or default is to be paid semi-
annually, on the 20th day of May and of November in each and
every year, and is specified by interest notes or coupons of even
date herewith, attached to the said note and payable at said
