

condition, that whereas said Joseph L. Taylor has his day executed and delivered his certain promissory coupon note in writing to said party of the second part, in the sum of two thousand dollars, payable five years after date with interest thereon, payable annually, at the rate of eight per cent, per annum specified by five coupon interest rates here to attached.

Now, If said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, said sum of money and the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same and particularly according to the terms of the said coupon note coupons, sum whose presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum, or sum of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sum is, and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents do become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
