Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred fifty Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Lots Number five & six seven eight & nine of Ten 10 and Eleven 11 in Block One hundred forty six 146 in the City of Eudora according to the plat of said City, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
