

of the sum of Two hundred Dollars on or before five years from the date of this instrument with interest thereon at the rate of ten per cent per annum according to the terms of one certain promissory note, this day executed and delivered by the said George Washington unto the said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or due taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole shall become due ^{as} payable and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not, at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the surplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale, on demand, to the said George Washington his heirs or assigns.
